RULES FOR USE OF THE POOLS & SPA

The Sun City Civic Association (SCCA) facilities are maintained, managed, and operated under the direction of the SCCA Board of Directors, in accordance with the Association's Governing Documents and all applicable Federal, state, and local laws.

Use of the SCCA recreational facilities shall not conflict with the Association's primary purposes, overburden the facilities, or unreasonably prevent Eligible Residents from having a fair opportunity to use the facilities.

Use of the Association's pools, Spa (Jacuzzi), and Exercise Room is restricted to Eligible Residents. In accordance with the SCCA Facilities Use Procedure, an "Eligible Resident" is defined as a resident of the SCCA who has a valid Resident Activity Card in his or her name. Each Eligible Resident may bring four (4) Guests to use the pools during Guest swimming hours. The Board of Directors determines guest swimming hours. Guests are not permitted in the Spa or Exercise Room.

It is the desire of the SCCA to promote and protect the rights of all Eligible Residents and their Guests during their use of the recreational facilities. In order to preserve an enjoyable social atmosphere for everyone, the SCCA, through its agents and/or employees reserves the right to deny access to, or terminate the immediate use of, the facilities to any person and/or their guest who are creating a nuisance or interfering with the rights of others seeking enjoyment of the facilities. For the purposes of this procedure, "nuisance" includes, but is not limited to, offensive, obnoxious, unreasonably loud, disturbing, or threatening language or behavior, recklessness that threatens the health and safety of others, or being under the influence of drugs or alcohol, or other act or behavior that, as determined in the reasonable discretion of the SCCA, its agents and/or employees, unreasonably interferes with the use and enjoyment of the facilities by others; such denial/termination may be made on verbal demand, including that the person(s) immediately leave the facilities. Suspension or termination on a longer term is subject to SCCA's Enforcement/Fine Schedule.

1. Eligible Residents must sign in and out each time they use the Facilities, and may be asked to present their Resident Activity Card to the Facility Monitor.
2. Guests will be signed in by the Eligible Resident who brings them. The Guest's name must be signed on the line following the Eligible Resident's name. The word "Guest" should be entered in the Space intended for the SCCA number. Eligible residents must remain with their Guests during the entire time the Guest is on the SCCA Facilities.

3. No person shall spend more time in the Spa as is recommended by his or her personal medical doctor or other similar authority.
4. Persons who are unable to safely swim and/or otherwise stay afloat in water ranging from 3 to 10 feet in the pool shall refrain from using the pools. Additionally, adult accompaniment and supervision is required for persons under the age of 14.
5. Persons suffering from an impairment that may prevent them from safely using the pools and Spa must be accompanied by a person who can assist them. SCCA personnel are not authorized or permitted to do so. Wheelchairs or other mechanical devices shall be placed in a manner as necessary for use and access, and so as not to inhibit others use, entry into and/or exit from the pool or spa.
6. It is recommended persons intending to use the pools or Spa shower before each use. The showers are provided for this purpose only, and are not intended for daily personal hygiene. Shaving is not permitted in the pools, Spa, restroom, shower or dressing facilities.
7. Swimming attire must be worn in the pools and Spa (no cutoffs, "T" Shirts are acceptable). A swim cap or other device to contain the hair must be worn by any person whose hair is longer than their collar line.
8. Lotions, oils, or creams, other than sunscreens, are not permitted. These products may not be worn on the skin during use of the pools and spa.
9. No pool/spa user having a communicable disease while in an infectious state, including but not limited to cryptosporidium, giardia, Legionnaires' disease, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa infection, or while having any symptoms such as a cough, cold or sores, or nasal or ear discharges, or when wearing bandages, shall enter the pool or Spa unless he or/she submits current written statement to the SCCA office signed by a licensed physician confirming he/she does not present a health hazard to others using the pool/Spa facilities. (Ref.CA Code of Regulations, Title 22, 65541).
10. No inflatables are permitted in the pool, Spa, restrooms, or shower areas. Recreational swimming aids and Swimming aids used for physical rehabilitation purposes, or floatation devices worn on the body ("floaties" worn on the upper arms, life jackets, noodles etc.) are permitted.
11. Aquatic shoes (shoes designed for use in a pool) may be worn anywhere within the pool and Spa areas, including the shower and dressing areas.

12. Pool furniture and other objects are not to be placed within five (5) feet of the edge of the pools.
13. Alcoholic beverages are permitted at special events with SCCA Board approval – illegal drugs and illegal activities are prohibited on SCCA property.
14. Smoking is not allowed in any building or in the pool areas. The SCCA Campus is a smoke free facility. Additionally, use of “E” cigarettes or other vapor delivery systems is also prohibited.
15. For Safety purposes, NO diving, running, jumping, or “horse play” shall be permitted in or around pools and Spa.
16. Expectoring or other contamination of the pools, Spa, restrooms, showers, or dressing facilities is not permitted.
17. Containers made of glass or other breakable materials are not permitted in the pool areas, pools, Spa, restrooms, or dressing facilities. Non-alcoholic beverages in plastic or aluminum containers are permitted, but not within five (5) feet of the pool or Spa.
18. Food is not permitted within five (5) feet of the pools. Food is not permitted in the Spa, restrooms, showers, or dressing facilities.
19. Please keep the pool and Spa area sanitary and clean. No incontinent persons, diapers, swimming diapers, or persons who are not toilet trained are allowed in the pool or Spa. Any contamination of the pool and Spa facilities by members and/or guests may result in denial of, access to, or termination of the right to use the pool and Spa.

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
