### MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

At the July 28, 2016 meeting, the Board of Directors unanimously passed a motion to move forward with updating the entire set of CC&Rs. The entire set of tract CC&Rs was forwarded to the law firm of Fiore, Racobs & Powers to review and incorporate all tract CC&Rs to form one updated set of CC&Rs. Peter Racobs is currently working on a draft to submit to the Board for review. We want to emphasize the importance of member participation in the voting process. We must get a majority of the membership to vote to reach a quorum and two thirds of those casting a vote must be affirmative to make any change in the CC&Rs. Once we get the final draft of the proposed CC&Rs, we will hold another Town Hall Meeting to discuss the changes.

We are approaching the fall season when the Maintenance Committee, the Finance Committee, the Board, and Avalon Management begin working on the budget for 2017. All clubs and committees should review their projected expenses that are passed on to the SCCA so that they may be considered in the annual budgeting process.

# Pickle-ball, SCCA's newest club, looking for members

Pickle-ball has finally come to Sun City! One of the SCCA's newest clubs, we had over 30 people at our Open House on August 31. The old outdoor shuffleboard area at the north end of North Town Hall has been converted into a temporary court. Residents of the Core are invited to watch and/or join in match play. Covered seating and free lessons will be available. Contact the SCCA office for membership information and schedule.

Pickle-ball was invented in 1965 on Bainbridge Island, outside Seattle, WA. The goal, then and now, was to create a game that is fun for all ages. It started out as a backyard game relying on a hodgepodge of gear from other racket games like badminton and ping-pong. Pickle-ball quickly evolved and came into its own. The founders jettisoned table tennis paddles and began making their own Pickle-ball paddles, which were more suited to the game, using a wood jigsaw and marine plywood. Those who had access to badminton courts simply lowered the net. Others set up courts in their driveways and backyards, drawing lines with chalk. News of the fun new game spread by word-of-mouth. Pickle-ball continued to gain in popularity over the years due to its accessibility for players of all ages and abilities, while still allowing players that are more competitive to test their



mettle.

In 1972, Pickle-ball was officially incorporated to give the game a proper hub and keep up with the demand for paddles, balls, nets and other gear.

Pickle-ball is played on a badminton-sized court: 20' x 44'. In addition to the modified net and gear, there are several key rules in Pickle-ball that help make the game more accessible. The ball is served diagonally (starting with the right-hand service-square), and points can only be scored by the side that serves. Players on each side must

let the ball bounce once before volleys are allowed, and there is a seven-foot no-volley zone on each side of the net to prevent "spiking." The server continues to serve, alternating service courts, until he or she faults.

The first side scoring eleven points and leading by at least two points wins. Pickle-ball can be played with singles or doubles.

Today Pickle-ball is played all over the world through community groups, PE classes, YMCA, retirement communities and more.

According to a recent article

there are more than 2,000,000 people playing Pickle-ball in the US alone, and the game is growing exponentially. Many senior communities in our area have added courts to satisfy demand. Public courts are not as plentiful, but are so popular that folks are lined up to play. Please join us, and help us show our community all the benefits that Pickle-ball has to offer!

The Boomerangz club "Wine and Cheese Mixer" on 8/19/2016 had almost eighty residents attend this event. What a fantastic turnout for a new club that had six charter members.

The remodel of the Olympic Pool restrooms has gone back to the drawing board. The original model plans included expanding the restroom south from the existing wall, which would change traffic flow through the area. This plan got a lot of negative feedback from the

membership. The Board in a special meeting voted to change the plans to fit in the original footprint. The Maintenance committee, the Finance Committee, and the Board are reviewing the new proposed plans. If you want to see a copy of the proposed floorplans ask at the SCCA office. Our plumbing bill for July/August was over \$900.00 to clear drains on the campus. On two occasions, the plumber pulled items from the main drain that never should have

been in the toilets. Our residents and their guests need to be careful of what they are placing in the toilets.

Several times over the summer months, the staff has setup rooms for clubs that had not notified management that they were not going to meet. In the future clubs that do not notify management that scheduled rooms will not be used will be charged a setup fee.

## California Eye Doctor Helps Legally Blind To See

*High Technology For Low Vision Patients Allows Many To Drive Again*

For many patients with macular degeneration and other vision-related conditions, the loss of central visual detail also signals the end to one of the last bastions of independence - driving. California Low Vision Optometrist Dr. Richard Shuldiner is using miniaturized telescopes which are mounted in glasses to help people who have lost vision from macular degeneration and other eye conditions.

"Some of my patients consider me the last chance

for people who have vision loss" said Dr. Shuldiner, "most people don't know that there are low vision optometrists who have extensive experience in helping those with vision loss. We help people with macular

There are two types of macular degeneration: wet and dry. There is no treatment for the dry form, which is caused by aging, sunlight, smoking, and genetics. The damage in the wet form is caused by blood vessels leaking fluid. Treatment is aimed at stopping the leak and preventing further leaks. The vision cannot be regained in either type. This is where low vision glasses can help.

While there is currently no cure, promising research is being done on many fronts. "My job is to figure out everything and anything possible to keep a person functioning" says Dr. Shuldiner. "Even if it's driving."

"The major benefit of bioptic

telescope low vision glasses is magnifying road signs, traffic lights and other distance objects necessary for safe driving".




## PET CORNER

Alert: if you missed warnings on tv and in newspapers, Lake Elsinore and some other lakes have been hit with algae that can kill dogs within a half hour! They ingest more water than humans when swimming so please leave your dogs at home and maybe we should stay home too!

For those that love to watch and feed hummingbirds here is a hummingbird mix recipe for making your own and no food coloring is needed. Mix  $\frac{1}{4}$  cup sugar to 1 cup water or for bigger feeders mix  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup sugar to 2 cups water. Food coloring can rot the hummers tongues. It's simple to mix and brings to enjoyment to them and all of us that are watching them.

I hope everyone has enjoyed the summer but i must say that my dogs are not too happy with this time of year at all! Between grass pollens, plant pollens and just plain old pollen pollens they are biting and scratching themselves constantly. Our groomer bathed them with medicated shampoo, but this just didn't seem to do very much for the scratching. Our vet sometimes recommends a shot of prednisone with some low milligram prednisone pills to see if it stops it. Usually this does.. But not this year! Dr. Hempel told us about a new product that has come out that could hopefully save our pets from having so many problems with their teeth. It's called oravet dental hygiene chews. Each chew releases delmopinol hci, which coats the teeth, tongue, and gingiva to create a barrier that prevents bacterial attachment. When bacteria cannot attach to oral surfaces, they cannot create the biofilms that become plaque or produce the volatile sulfur compounds of bad breath. Delmopinol not only reduces plaque formation, it also breaks down existing plaque so it can be removed by the mechanical scrubbing action of the chew. I bought a couple of boxes of oravet and after mandy and baily's gums heal we will start all of them on this product to see if it does what it says. If it does this sure would be a major saving for us.
